MAINTAINING WATER QUALITY INFORMATION

The City of Milpitas is dedicated to maintaining water quality and protecting the water supply to be able to provide safe and reliable drinking water to all of Milpitas.



To ensure that tap water is safest to drink, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) prescribe regulations that limit the amount of certain contaminants in water provided by public water systems. The SWRCB's regulations also establish limits for contaminants in bottled water that provide the same protection for public health.

The City of Milpitas has an active and aggressive local monitoring program, the results of which are published annually in the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR). This annual water quality report tells you where our water comes from, what tests show about it, and more. You can be assured that the safety of your water supply has remained our top priority and we will always notify you immediately if there is any reason for concern about our water.

In compliance with the SWRCB's regulations, the 2022 CCR will be made available on or before July 1, 2023. To view prior CCR's, please visit the City's website at milpitas.gov/water-quality-report.
