## **City of Milpitas Appoints New Fire Chief**

City Manager Steven G. McHarris is pleased to announce the appointment of Deputy Fire Chief Jason Schoonover as the new Fire Chief for the City of Milpitas.

Chief Schoonover joined the Milpitas Fire Department in 2013 as a Fire Battalion Chief and was promoted to Deputy Fire Chief in 2022. During his career with the Milpitas Fire Department, he managed the Training Division and Special Operations Divisions, and also served as the Fire Department's Dispatch/Communications Liaison. Chief Schoonover has been a member of the City's Emergency Operations Team working in the areas of emergency management, hazard mitigation planning, critical infrastructure identification and much more. Prior to joining Milpitas, he worked for 14 years with the Marysville Fire Authority in Washington State, spending his final seven years as a Fire Captain.

City Manager McHarris said, "Incoming Chief Schoonover has been a valued leader throughout his years of service. His experience, training, and community involvement are reflective of his professional dedication to the Milpitas Fire Department and the City of Milpitas. I know that he will be a valuable mentor and leader to grow the next generation of public safety teams integral to our community."
