Permit applications are due ninety (90) days prior to commencing discharge to the sanitary system or expiration of existing discharge permit. Any person who fails to file an application for a discharge permit prior to discharge shall be assessed a penalty for delinquent filing as follows: (1) Up to and including thirty (30) days delinquency, the penalty shall be fifty percent (50%) of the permit fee. More than thirty (30) days but less than one year delinquency, the penalty shall be one hundred percent (100%) of the permit fee. (3) More than one(1) year delinquency, the penalty shall be one thousand percent (1,000%) of the permit fee. (b) Such penalties shall be in addition to any other penalties or fines that may be levied, and in addition to any other remedies that the City may have with respect to the discharge.
