RESPONSIBLE CONSTRUCTION ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY

For a Project meeting the definition below, this form is required prior to issuance of a building permit.

Effective January 1, 2012, [California Labor Code section 2810.5](#) requires that all non-exempt employees be given written notice of their regular rate of pay, wage status and designated payday at time of hire. Any non-exempt employee covered by a valid collective bargaining agreement does not need to be given a written notice if the agreement expressly provides for the wages, hours of work and working conditions of the employee, and the agreement provides premium wage rates of all overtime hours worked and a regular hourly rate of pay for those employees of not less than 30 percent more than the state minimum wage.
