Medi-Cal provides free or low-cost health care coverage to many individuals and families. There are several different Medi-Cal programs, and each category has its own requirements.

All individuals are encouraged to apply, and a county worker will determine which plan you will qualify for.

CalFresh Food is California's name for the federal food program called Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) that used to be known as Food Stamps.

CalFresh Food is a nutrition program that allows you buy healthy food at most food outlets, grocery stores, farmers markets and some restaurants.

Eligibility is based your family size, income, and some living costs.

Benefits are deposited on an Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card, that works like a debit card.

If you need food right away, you may qualify for Expedited Services, if you qualify you will get benefits within 3 days.

RESTAURANT MEALS PROGRAM

The CalFresh Food Restaurant Meals Program allows CalFresh Food recipients who are 60 years of age or older, disabled, or homeless to use their CalFresh Food benefits to purchase prepared meals at approved participating restaurants.

If you are over 60, disabled, or homeless CalFresh Food customer, you may purchase meals at any participating restaurants.

CALFRESH EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING (CFET)

WHAT IS THE CALFRESH EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING (CFET) PROGRAM

CFET is a program that helps CalFresh Food recipients gain skills, tools, and training to find a living wage job. Participants can engage in a variety of activities: Supervised Job Search, Work Experience, Vocational Training, Pre-apprenticeship/Apprenticeship, Adult Education, and Job Retention. Fee is waived for CalFresh recipients.

WHAT CAN CFET HELP YOU DO?

Some things CFET may help you do are:

- Start a career;
- Write an effective resume;
- Receive paid work experience;
- Improve your interviewing skills;
- Get your high school equivalency certificate;
- Learn new job skills in professional, technical, or vocational programs;
- And help you meet your ABAWD work requirements to keep your CalFresh Food benefits!
