




SAFER STREETS with DAYLIGHTING

Background

- Based on recent studies, **50% of all traffic-related injuries occur near intersections.**
- To improve safety on the street, Assemblymember Alex Lee (D-San Jose) sponsored **AB 413** or the Daylighting Bill in 2023 that aims to improve everyone's visibility on intersections.
- Signed into law in February 2024, effective immediately.
- Effective **January 1, 2025**, you could be issued a citation for violating this new California law.



Daylighting



- Makes intersections more visible to pedestrians and motorists alike by mandating the **removal of any visual barriers within a minimum of 20 feet from an intersection.**
- Vehicles are not to **stop, stand or or park within 20 feet** of any marked or unmarked crosswalk
