## 2024 STREET SEALING PROJECT – Phase 2, CP4305

### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- **Q1: What is the 2025 Street Sealing Project?**

A: The 2024 Street Sealing Project involves applying a Cape Seal treatment to selected streets throughout Milpitas to extend pavement life, improve surface conditions, and reduce long-term maintenance costs.

- **Q2: What is a Cape Seal?**

A: A Cape Seal is a two-step roadway surface treatment combining a chip seal followed by a slurry seal. This process provides a durable, weather-resistant surface that extends pavement life and improves driving conditions.

- **Q3: When will the work take place?**

A: Work is scheduled to begin in Summer 2025 and will be completed in phases by September 2025. Residents will receive notifications in advance of any planned work in their neighborhood.

- **Q4: How long will each street be affected?**

A: Typically, work on each street takes 1-2 days for chip seal application, followed by an additional 1-2 days for slurry seal, depending on weather and curing time. Streets will be accessible after each phase unless otherwise noted.

- **Q5: Will I be able to access my driveway during the work?**

A: Access to driveways may be temporarily restricted during sealing operations and curing times. Notifications will be provided with specific instructions and timelines.

- **Q6: Will street parking be allowed?**

A: Street parking will be restricted during construction on affected streets. Temporary 'No Parking' signs will be posted at least 72 hours in advance.

- **Q7: Will my trash and recycling pickup be affected?**

A: Trash and recycling services will continue as scheduled. Please place bins as usual unless otherwise instructed by City notices.
