NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

To Adopt the 2022-2025 Consolidated Plan (ConPlan)/2022-2023 Annual Action Plan (AAP)

Notice is hereby given that on June 14, 2022, at 5:30 PM, the Milpitas City Council will hold a hybrid public hearing in person at Milpitas City Hall, 455 E. Calaveras Blvd and via Zoom webinar. This is the second of two Public Hearings for the FINAL version of the 2022-2025 Consolidated Plan (ConPlan)/2022-2023 Annual Action Plan (AAP). The purpose of the Public Hearing is to provide one last opportunity for public comment on the 2022-2025 ConPlan/2022-2023 AAP, and for City staff to review public comments received during the 30-day public comment period. After all public comments have been considered, the City Council will adopt the 2022-2025 ConPlan/2022-2023 AAP.

Written comments will be digitally distributed to the City Council if received on the public hearing date by 5:00 PM and will be part of this meeting's public record.
