

**ARTS COMMISSION:** Founded October 17, 2000. On June 3, 2014, the City Council directed the Arts Commission and Public Art Committee to be combined and the duties of both executed by the Arts Commission. Meetings are held bi-monthly on fourth Mondays in January, March, May, September, and November at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room. One Milpitas Unified School District representative is a voting member on the Commission. Arts consists of seven members and two alternate members appointed to 3-year terms and may have two non-voting students appointed.

**COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMISSION:** Founded July 20, 1954. Meetings are held monthly on first Wednesdays at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room. CAC is advisory on matters affecting Milpitas citizens, especially community improvement. CAC evaluates and makes recommendations to the City Council on issues including Citywide beautification, community and neighborhood clean-up and abatement issues. Main CAC responsibility is to make recommendations annually to the Council on federal Community Development Block Grants. CAC consists of seven members and two alternates who are appointed to 3-year terms.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & TRADE COMMISSION:** Founded February 18, 2003. Meetings are held monthly on the second Monday at 4:30 PM in the City Hall Committee Room (no meetings July and December). The commission was established to advise the Council on business issues and to make recommendations on development, and implementation of a comprehensive economic development program for the City of Milpitas. 7 members and 2 alternates are appointed to 3-year terms and represent specific industries and business segments in Milpitas.

**ENERGY & ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY COMMISSION:** Founded February 5, 1991. Meetings are held monthly on the third Wednesday of each month except in July at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Committee Room. Initially founded as Solid Waste Reduction Advisory Commission in June 1993. Advises Council on matters pertaining to recycling and solid waste management. Commissioners recommend programs designed to reduce solid waste, promote recycling, and monitor the City's achievement of state-mandated diversion goals. Seven members and two alternates are appointed to 3-year terms.

**LIBRARY & EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMISSION:** Founded January 17, 1961. Meetings are held on second Monday of January and third Mondays of March, May, September, and November at 7:00 PM at the Milpitas Public Library. Advises the Santa Clara County Library which operates the Milpitas Library under the jurisdiction of a Joint Powers Authority, informs Council and County Librarian of community needs for library activities and levels of service. Seven members and two alternates are appointed to 3-year terms.

**PARKS, RECREATION & CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION:** Founded July 1, 1992. Meetings are held monthly on the first Monday at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room. PRCRC was formed when the Council combined functions of Parks & Recreation Commission and Cultural Resources Preservation Board into one body. Advises Council on recreation services and historic preservation activities, and advises in the acquisition, planning, and development of new and existing parks and facilities. PRCRC assists with activities on the City's cultural heritage. 7 members and 2 alternates serve 3-year terms.

**PLANNING COMMISSION:** Meetings are held on second and fourth Wednesdays every month except July at 7:00 PM in the City Council Chambers at City Hall. Planning Commission consists of seven members appointed to 3-year terms. Commissioners have responsibilities specifically related to land use decisions on zoning, the General Plan, Housing Element and other documents and development plans. Must be a registered voter in the City of Milpitas and members receive a small stipend.

**PUBLIC SAFETY & EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMISSION:** Founded April 23, 1988. Meetings are held bi-monthly on third Thursdays in January, March, May, September, and November at 7:00 PM at Main Fire Station. The Public Safety & Emergency Preparedness Commission advises the City Council regarding emergency preparedness, disaster planning and matters of public safety. PSEPC consists of 7 members and 2 alternates who are appointed to 3-year terms.

**SENIOR ADVISORY COMMISSION:** Founded April 20, 1993. Meetings are held bi-monthly on the fourth Tuesdays of February, April, June, August, October, and December at 1:30 PM at the Barbara Lee Senior Center. Originally founded as the Senior Advisory Committee in 1978, the SAC advises the Council on matters pertaining to recreation, health/nutrition and other services for senior citizens of Milpitas. 7 members and 2 alternates serve 3-year terms.

**SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY & INNOVATION COMMISSION:** Founded September 6, 1994. Meetings are held monthly on third Mondays at 7:00 PM at City Hall. Information technology and a variety of information services offer challenges to Milpitas, so Commissioners advise on technology policy, legislation, and implementation. 7 members and 2 alternates are appointed to 3-year terms.

**VETERANS COMMISSION:** Founded December 1, 2009. Meetings are held bi-monthly on the first Wednesday in February, April, June, August, October, and December at 5:30 PM in the City Hall Committee Room. Seven members and two alternates with 3-year terms are appointed by the City Council to advise the Council on matters pertaining to veterans in Milpitas. All Commissioners are current or retired U.S. military service members.

**YOUTH ADVISORY COMMISSION:** Founded May 21, 1996. Meetings are held monthly (excluding July) on second Thursdays at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room. Youth Commissioners must be students in grades 7 through 12, who live in Milpitas. The YAC advises the City Council on issues concerning healthy & safety and recreation for youth and teens in Milpitas. 7 members and 2 alternates are appointed to 3-year terms.
