Arts Commission	Bi-monthly on 4th Monday in Jan, March, May, Sept, and Nov. at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises the Council on matters pertaining to the arts in Milpitas, as well as serve as the advisory body for the public art program. One Milpitas Unified School District representative is a voting member on the Commission. Seven members, two alternate members, and two non-voting student members appointed to 3-year terms.
Community Advisory Commission	Monthly on 1 st Wednesday at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises on matters affecting Milpitas citizens, especially community improvement. CAC evaluates and makes recommendations to the City Council on issues including Citywide beautification, community and neighborhood clean-up and abatement issues. Seven members, two alternate members, and one non-voting student member.
Economic Development & Trade Commission	Monthly on 2 nd Monday at 4:30 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises the Council on business issues and to make recommendations on development, and implementation of a comprehensive economic development program for the City of Milpitas. Seven members, two alternate members, and one non-voting student member. All members and alternates shall be Milpitas residents OR own a business OR be currently employed at a business located within the City limits of Milpitas. Members represent the Chamber of Commerce, MUSD, Technology and Trade, Business, Commercial Real Estate, and Hospitality. The MUSD Board appoints a member to serve on the Commission and that member is confirmed by the City Council.
Energy & Environmental Sustainability Commission	Monthly on 3 rd Wednesday at 6:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises Council on matters pertaining to recycling and solid waste management, recommending programs designed to reduce solid waste, promote recycling, and monitor the City's achievement of state-mandated diversion goals. Seven members, two alternate members, and one non-voting student member. All members and alternates shall be Milpitas residents OR own a business OR be currently employed at a business located within the City limits of Milpitas. Members include Environmental Interest Group, Business, and Residents. The MUSD Board appoints a member to serve on the Commission and that member is confirmed by the City Council.
Library & Education Advisory Commission	Meets at 7:00 PM on 2 nd Monday of Jan., and 3 rd Mondays of March, May, Sept., Nov. in Milpitas Public Library Conference Room	Advises the Santa Clara County Library which operates the Milpitas Library under the jurisdiction of a Joint Powers Authority, informs Council and County Librarian of community needs for library activities and levels of service. Seven members, two alternate members, and one non-voting student member.
Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources Commission	Monthly on 1 st Monday at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises Council on recreation services and historic preservation activities, and advises in the acquisition, planning, and development of new and existing parks and facilities. Nine members, two alternate members, and one non-voting student member
Planning Commission	Monthly on 2 nd and 4 th Wednesdays at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Council Chamber	Consists of seven appointed commissioners. Commissioners have responsibilities specifically related to land use decisions on zoning, the General Plan, Housing Element and other documents and development plans. Must be a registered voter in the City of Milpitas and members receive a small stipend.
Public Safety & Emergency Preparedness Commission	3 rd Thursdays of Jan., March, May, Sept., Nov. at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises the City Council regarding emergency preparedness, disaster planning and matters of public safety. Seven members, two alternate members, and one non-voting student member.
Science, Technology & Innovation Commission	3 rd Mondays of Feb., April, June, Sep., Nov., and Dec. at 7:00 PM in City Hall Committee Room	Advises the Council on technology policy, legislation, and implementation. Seven members, two alternate members, and one non-voting student member.
Senior Advisory Commission	4 th Tuesday of Feb., Apr., June, Aug., Oct., Dec at 1:30 PM at Barbara Lee Senior Center	Advises the Council on matters pertaining to recreation, health/nutrition and other services for senior citizens of Milpitas. Seven members, two alternate members. Members must be 50 years or older and members of the Milpitas Barbara Lee Senior Center.
Veterans Commission	1 st Wednesdays of Feb., Apr., June, Aug., Oct., Dec. at 5:30 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises the Council on matters pertaining to veterans in Milpitas. All members must be current or retired U.S. military service members. Seven members and two alternate members.
Youth Advisory Commission	Monthly on 2 nd Thursday at 7:00 PM in the City Hall Committee Room	Advises the Council on issues concerning health & safety and recreation for youth and teens in the City of Milpitas. Commissioners are students in Grades 7-12 who live in Milpitas. Seven members and two alternate members.
