 - b. What is the Engineer's estimate for this project?
 - **City Response**: The engineer's estimate for the base project, with no alternate bid items included, is approximately \$ 3.5 Million.
 - c. Is this project subject to PLA?
 - **City Response**: No, there is no Project Labor Agreement associated with this project. However, the project is still subject to any prevailing wage requirements indicated in the contract specifications.
 - d. When does the city anticipate a start date?
 - **City Response**: The City is anticipating a start date of mid-April to early-May.
 - e. The bid schedule bid item #12 (Asphalt Concrete Grinding (2.5")) is missing estimate quantity
 - The estimate quantity for bid schedule bid item #12 (Asphalt Concrete Grinding (2.5")) was moved to Alternate #1 Mt Shasta Avenue bid item #8 ((Asphalt Concrete Grinding (2.5")). This work is an add alternate bid item, subject to addition to the base project at the time of base project award.

Bidders must provide pricing for every bid item. The costs for any Work shown or required in the Contract Documents, but not specifically identified as a line item are to be included in the related line items and no additional compensation shall be due to Contractor for the performance of the Work.

In case of discrepancy between the Unit Price and the Total Item Price set forth for a unit basis item, the unit price shall prevail and shall be utilized as the basis for determining the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder. However, if the amount set forth as a unit price is ambiguous, unintelligible or uncertain for any cause, or is omitted, or is the same amount as the entry in the "Item Price" column, then the amount set forth in the "Item Price" column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the Unit Price.

For purposes of evaluating Bids, the City will correct any apparent errors in the extension of unit prices and any apparent errors in the addition of lump sum and extended prices.

The estimated quantities for Unit Price items are for purposes of comparing Bids only and the City makes no representation that the actual quantities of work performed will not vary from the estimates. Final payment shall be determined by the Engineer from measured quantities of work performed based upon the Unit Price.

If the Contract Documents specify Alternate Bid items, the following Alternate Bid amounts shall be added to or deducted from the Total Bid Price entered above (please check the appropriate box), in the City's sole discretion. The City can choose to include any, all, or none of the Alternate Bid items in the Work. If the City selects any of the Alternate Bid items, the corresponding Alternate Bid prices shall be added to or deducted from Base Bid Price for the Work. No additional working days will be added to the base contract with the selection of any of the Alternate Bid items. **The City shall award any selected Alternate Bid items at the time of base project award.**
