Get a free face covering.

Milpitas service clubs are partnering with the City and other volunteer organizations to make and distribute free face coverings to those in need. Because of the high demand, free face coverings will be provided to **Milpitas residents only and limited to two per household**, while supplies last. Priority is given to households that include seniors or others with underlying medical conditions that put them at a greater risk for COVID-19. Distribution will be scheduled in accordance with strict social distancing. Face coverings are not required for children 6 years old and under. Donate face coverings for others in need.
